PROPOSITION T

Shall Jefferson County, Missouri, levy a tax of five percent (5%) on each sleeping room occupied and rented by "transient guests" ("person or persons who occupy a room or rooms...for thirty-one days or less," as defined by RSMo 67.1000) of "hotels and motels" (defined as an establishment that provides lodging and/or parking or rooms that are accessible to an outdoor parking area and usually provides meals, entertainment and various personal services for the public to include but not limited to hotels, motels, bed & breakfasts, inns, and commercially operated short term rentals such as vacation homes, condominiums, or rooms listed on platforms like Airbnb or Vrbo, etc.) located in the County, to exclude any hotels and motels in any municipality within the County that already imposes a transient tax under RSMo 67.1000 or any other transient tax under Missouri law, where the proceeds of which shall be expended solely for funding a convention and visitors bureau?
